Programme Briefs

Bachelor of Science (Nursing and Midwifery)

This is a self sponsored programme and hence students being admitted to the programme will be expected to pay full fees as stipulated above. There are however 30 scholarships which will be awarded on merit.

The graduate will be equipped with scientific and practical knowledge, and transferable skills to be professionally competent to provide comprehensive quality nursing and midwifery care in Malawi and beyond. The programme aims at producing a graduate nurse-midwife who is client-centred, culturally sensitive, accountable, self-motivated, a change agent, an educator, a manager and a researcher. It covers courses such as basic sciences, nursing and midwifery sciences, behavioural sciences, management and leadership, research and biomedical sciences.

Security Studies

Graduates of these programmes will be equipped with professional knowledge and transferable skills in security sector management that will enable them respond to emerging challenges in the security sector. The programmes offer among others the following courses; Nature of Security, Security Law, Security Resources Management, Immigration and Development, Military History, International Relations, Correctional Management and Public Policy Process. The programmes target officers, managers and other actors from Defence, Police, National Intelligence Services, Immigration, Correction Service, Anti Corruption Bureau, Revenue Collection Authority, Fiscal Management Services, Media and the Judiciary.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application letters should be sent by post, or delivered by hand at Mzuzu University Campus in the Registry. Applications sent by e-mail or by fax will **NOT** be accepted. Applicants making more than one application will be disqualified.

Application letters should include a non-refundable admission application fee of **K 2,000** for Malawian applicants and US\$ 100 for international applicants. Applications submitted without the admission application fee will be disqualified.

Candidates who are currently registered and studying at another public institution of higher learning and candidates who were withdrawn from any institution of higher learning on academic grounds are not eligible to apply for admission.

Payment of Admission Application Fee

The application fee can be paid by any of the following ways:

- a) by **cash** at the University Campus, Cashier's Office in the Department of Finance (please attach the receipt firmly to the application form), or
- b) by **bank certified cheque**, **postal order or money order** (please attach the bank certified cheque, postal order or money order firmly to the application form).

The application fee is non-refundable.
